Social Dysfunctions: Exploring Mechanisms and Advancing Therapeutic Interventions

Alterations in social abilities have profound effects on individuals, their families, public health, and long-term life outcomes. Notably, different neurodevelopmental, neurological and psychiatric disorders have as core features impaired social cognition and have difficulties forming and maintaining social relationships. Additionally, many of these conditions are exacerbated by social stressors such as isolation or bullying, with reported cases of mental illnesses involving social deficits rising each year.

Understanding the neural underpinnings of social behaviors and their disruptions in psychiatric disorders requires a multifaceted approach. This workshop aims to address this challenge by bringing together young researchers, leading scientists, and key industrial partners. Through the integration of cutting-edge technologies, interdisciplinary expertise, and translational insights, our goal is to advance the field of social neuroscience and pave the way for innovative therapeutic strategies targeting social impairments in psychiatric and neurodevelopmental disorders.
